Parents' Expectations

Model the expectations of class, respect and sportsmanship that we are asking of your sons.

Talk to your son about his experience. Be positive, supportive, and encouraging. Help him work through difficult times.

Leave the umpires alone. The coaches and players will also be letting them do their job. They will miss calls, that is normal at all levels.

Encourage your son to address any issues and/or concerns directly with the coaches. Before being tempted to contact coaches about one of your concerns talk to your sons – this is about them, let them learn how to handle it.

Get to know other parents in the program. We are working toward a family environment where community and inclusiveness is essential. Encourage others to come and support the team.

Be satisfied with whatever role your son has on the team and be proud of it.

Let your sons do what they do and what they have practiced for.

Be positive about every player no matter what the situation. If you don't have anything nice to say, don't say anything at all.

Be respectful of the other teams' players and fans.

Trust the coaches.

Be a role model and stay positive. Do not do anything to embarrass yourself and/or your son.
